Letter from the Editor

Is it already Records and Information Management Month?

The ICRM held another Virtual Mixer in March. Amanda Rindler CRM who is the Indiana University's University Records Managers spoke about the University's records destruction process "What?! The Indiana University Archives set a goal of reviewing records that had been accepted in the past to determine what has actually met its disposition per the records retention schedule. This has involved searching the accession database for duplicates and temporary records that were accepted prior to wide use of the records retention schedule. We have reviewed over 90 cubic feet and deaccessioned 60 cubic feet of records that were past retention or non-record material, with additional records identified for review. We have also been working on updating guidance and procedures regarding what is accepted.
